



Gun safety at home

Talk to your kids about guns.

- Talk about guns they see on television or in a video game. Make sure they understand how different that is from a gun in real life.
- Teach kids to NEVER touch a gun, and to always tell an adult right away if they see one.
- Kids are curious — even about a gun they have been told not to touch.

Talk to others about gun safety.

- If a visitor has a gun, provide them with a locked place to keep it while they are in your home.
- Talk to all caregivers about safe gun storage practice.
- Talk to other adults — wherever your kids visit or play — about safe gun storage.

If you have guns, store them safely at home:

- Keep guns locked with a cable or trigger lock at all times.
- Store guns in a lock box or safe, unloaded
- Keep ammunition locked and in a separate location.

Never leave guns out where kids can get to them.
