Christopher may not communicate his love and affection like a typical adolescent, but he sure does deserve to receive it. Christopher would benefit most from a structured household with direct communication—because he is autistic, he does not pick up on social cues or non-verbal suggestions. Christopher would benefit from being in a home with 1-2 caregivers who will use prompts, guidance, and positive reinforcement. Christopher is currently enrolled and working with the longterm waiver program, so he will have ongoing support from a case worker even after adoption. Christopher's current caregivers are able and willing to be a forever support to him and his forever family.
