

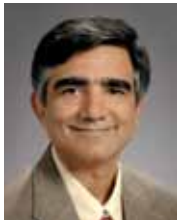
Children's Hospital of Wisconsin Endocrinology

Our diabetes program is one of the largest in the country, with more than 1,700 children with type 1, type 2 and other forms of diabetes seen in a multidisciplinary outpatient setting.

Full service diabetes care

- Office visits with a physician or nurse practitioners
- Diabetes management education for newly diagnosed patients
- Basic diabetes and self-management education
- One-on-one visits with a clinical nurse specialist or registered dietitian
- Ongoing medical follow-up until age 18
- 24-hour phone availability
- Teaching materials
- School support program
- Outpatient insulin pump program
- One-on-one visits with a social worker, and individual or group counseling with a psychologist
