Signup

Any school personnel can sign themselves up for BlueLoop by simply going to the website below, click SIGN UP, then SCHOOL PERSONNEL. Upon completing the short signup form, you are sent a welcome email with the next step, which is to get connected to your families.

Getting Connected to Family Accounts

When you signed up, 2 things happened.

1) You set up your own Username and Password – you'll need this to log into BlueLoop (same link as above).

2) You were assigned a "verification code", this 10-character code is important as it is your own personal code you give to any family in order to be able to access their Family BlueLoop account. This code is in your welcome email and can also be found on your account after logging in. See steps 1, 2 and 3.

So what if my family keeps putting off signing up?

All you need is verbal permission from a parent and YOU CAN SIGN UP YOUR STUDENT. Or simply call us and we can set up the family account. The family sign up is on our homepage by clicking SIGN UP, then selecting FAMILY SIGN UP. Once a family account is created, and your school verification code is entered on their account (there is a field for that), then you are connected. When you log into your school personnel account, that child's name appears on your student list – just click on their name and you are taken directly into their account.

So what can I do in a student's BlueLoop account?

Within a student's account, you can make entries, view dosage information, view and upload documents, and more. While there is a lot of things you can do on BlueLoop, school personnel will spend the vast majority of their time on the **DAILY ENTRY** screen and the **MED PROFILE** screen (highlighted 1 and 2 below).

1) The **DAILY ENTRY** screen is where you make entries like the Blood Glucose (BG), carbs, ketones, etc.... or to simply write Mom a note, like, "We need more insulin up here by Friday."

We also have an **Insulin Calculator** for those that still need to do the math! Once the Medical Profile is complete with the required fields, it is very simple to get an accurate insulin dose based on the child's blood sugar, any carbs they are eating, and for those wearing a CGM (e.g. Dexcom), we also calculate the insulin dose adjustment based on the CGM trend arrow.

2) The **MED PROFILE** screen is where current dosages and medication administration information resides (per the doctor's orders), as well as the setup for the insulin calculator (if needed). With parent permission, YOU can make updates to the Medical Profile. If you need help setting up the insulin calculator, please contact us.
