RE: NOTICE OF CHANGE OF IRB OF RECORD

Dear colleagues,

I am writing to notify you that Children's Wisconsin and the Medical College of Wisconsin have been longtime clinical and research partners and that continues with a 30-year affiliation agreement that went into effect July 1, 2021.

As part of this agreement, Children's Wisconsin is maintaining its Human Research Protection Program and is delegating IRB of record function to the Medical College of Wisconsin IRB. This applies to studies both currently under the jurisdiction of the Children's Wisconsin IRB and any new studies that are not relying on a third party IRB. The transfer of studies from the Children's Wisconsin IRB to the Medical College of Wisconsin IRB is currently underway and is expected to be completed by December 31, 2023. Children's Wisconsin IRB is no longer accepting new studies for review. For studies where reliance on a third party IRB is requested, Children's Wisconsin Human Research Protection Program will continue to execute reliance agreements between Children's Wisconsin and such third parties.

Please share this letter with individuals that are responsible for clinical research operations, the management of IRB reliance agreements, and any other relevant areas.
