

Join us during patient "rounds" for your child

At Children's Hospital of Wisconsin in Neenah we value parents as essential members of their child's health care team. We are committed to share information and involve you in care decisions during your child's hospitalization.

Many caregivers are involved in each child's care. It is important that all caregivers share information so the best and safest care can be delivered to each child. The information gathering to share information, known as "rounds" or "rounding", takes place at various times on each inpatient unit. Ask your child's nurse when the next care team rounding will occur for your child.

Doctors, nurses and other care providers meet to discuss each child's care plan. Parents are welcome to be present and participate in our rounds when the team comes to your child's bedside.

If there is anything you do not understand, please ask questions. Remember that every question or concern you have is important! We encourage you to ask questions and share any information you have learned or observed regarding your child at any time—not just during rounds—with any member of your child's care team.
