Dear Leader Schumer, Leader McConnell, Chairman Wyden, and Ranking Member Crapo:

The undersigned 269 national, state, and local organizations write to express our support for the bipartisan *Protecting America's Children by Strengthening Families Act* (H.R. 9076), which would invest critical new resources in Title IV-B of the Social Security Act and provide needed policy improvements, and to urge its swift consideration and passage in the U.S. Senate.

Over the past year, your bipartisan leadership has brought critical attention to the need to reauthorize Title IV-B and better support strong families. The *Protecting America's Children by Strengthening Families Act* responds to three priority areas outlined in <u>consensus</u> recommendations for reauthorizing Title IV-B of the Social Security Act:

1. Family – deepening federal support for comprehensive approaches to prevent child welfare system involvement and keep children with their families and in family-based placements as much as possible;

2. Mental health – policy improvements that complement ongoing mental health efforts by federal policymakers and support a trauma-responsive child welfare system that promotes healing; and

3. Workforce – investing in a workforce that values and supports thriving families.

This bill would expand by \$10 million annually the Court Improvement Program, which is the only direct child welfare-related federal funding that state and tribal courts receive to manage nearly 600,000 children's cases in court each year. The bill would also expand by \$10 million annually the Regional Partnership Grants, which address the intersection of parental substance use and child welfare involvement. The bill also allocates more IV-B funding for tribes, reduces barriers to tribal participation in IV-B, and supports oversight of implementation of the Indian Child Welfare Act.

Recognizing the vital role of strong families in supporting thriving children, the *Protecting America's Children by Strengthening Families Act* would further bolster the role of Title IV-B in supporting kinship caregivers. It would also create a clear commitment in federal law that poverty is not neglect, by underscoring the role of family preservation services for families experiencing a crisis related to a lack of resources. The bill's new policy and investments in the MaryLee Allen Promoting Safe and Stable Families program would also highlight the role of IV-B in primary prevention, by supporting community-based services and supports that prevent unnecessary child welfare involvement.

Responding to decades of level funding, the *Protecting America's Children by Strengthening Families Act* would provide the Promoting Safe and Stable Families program \$75 million annually in needed new mandatory funding.

We support the *Protecting America's Children by Strengthening Families Act* as an important step toward a child welfare system that better supports children and families. We thank the U.S. House for passing H.R. 9076 on an overwhelming bipartisan vote of 405-10, and look forward to the U.S. Senate's timely consideration and approval of this legislation.
