

## Sick Plan for Respiratory Infections

Phone When would my physician/nurse practitioner like to see my child again? When do I start the sick plan? This plan is to help your child during colds to hopefully avoid the need for antibiotic therapy. Start this plan when your child has symptoms of a runny nose, congestion, and cough. If your child's symptoms worsen after 5 days, or persist beyond 7 to 10 days, please notify your primary physician or specialist as listed above to discuss if additional evaluation or antibiotics are necessary for your child.  Medical Treatments.  Afrin. A nasal decongestant that is available over the counter. Use to each nostril every twelve hours for 3 days only.
