



# What's in your trunk?

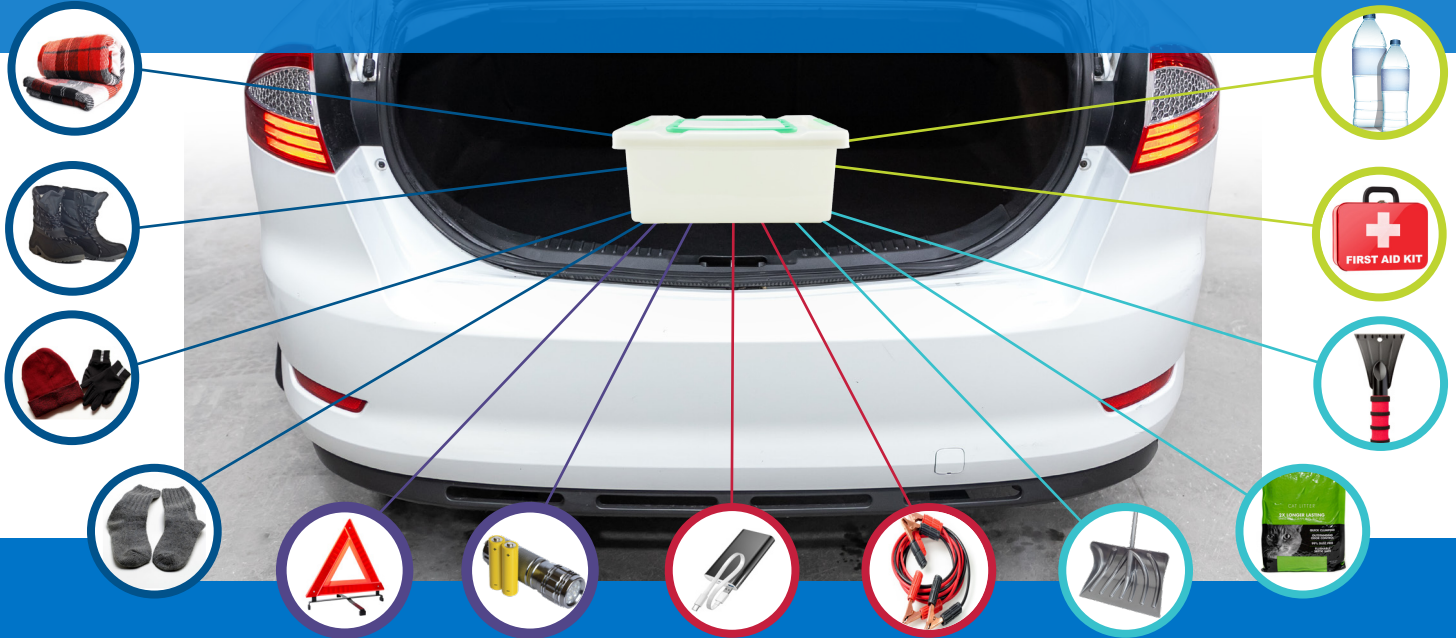

# Get rid of the junk. Put safety in your trunk.



**Warmth:** blanket, boots, hat/gloves, warm socks

**Visibility:** hazard triangle, flashlight and batteries

**Power:** portable phone charger, jumper cables

**Ice and snow removal:** Shovel, sand/kitty litter, ice scraper

**Other important necessities:** First-aid kit, snacks and water
