Regular License

- Must be at least age 19
- Drivers younger than 21 years old must maintain absolute sobriety.
- Issued when a driver completes the first renewal, generally two to three years after receiving the Probationary License.

Current Wisconsin Graduated Driver Licensing Law

Instruction Permit

Probationary License

- Minimum age is 15

- Enrolled in school (or graduated/GED)
- Enrolled in driver educationHave an adult sponsor
- Pass the knowledge test, sign test and vision screening

- Minimum age is 16
- Proof of approved driver education course completion
- Have a minimum of 50 hours of supervised driving with a qualified adult (10 hours must be at night)

- For the first nine months or until

age 18, passengers allowed are:

- Pass the driving skills test
- Have an adult sponsor
- Have no conviction for moving traffic violation for six months prior

- If younger than 18, a qualified adult must be in the front passenger seat at all times.
- Additional allowed passengers are immediate family members only.
- immediate family, one non-family member, and one qualified adult.
 5 am to midnight: drivers may be
- 5 am to midnight: drivers may be unsupervised and without destination limits.
- unsupervised only when driving between home, work and school. A qualified adult must be in the passenger seat for all other trips.

 Restrictions are extended six

months for moving violations or any violation of restrictions.

Qualified adult: a person with two years of driving experience who holds a valid, regular license and sits in the front seat. If this person is an instructor, parent/legal guardian or spouse, they must be at least 19 years of age; other adults must be 21 years of age.
