What is done prior to my student arriving at clinical?

- ✓ Caregiver Background Check
- ✓ Student Placement Certification
- ✓ CPR certification verified
- ✓ Obtain ID badge and parking permit prior to arrival on unit must call Security Administration to schedule appointment to obtain ID badge (414-266-3553). If the student has been a student at CHW in the past year they may stop at the Welcome Desk (main hospital lobby) and obtain their ID as their photo is on file.
- ✓ EPIC training: Your precepted student is required to schedule EPIC training at the start of their precepted experience. They should contact the Department of Advance Practice Nursing to schedule their training: CHWSPlacement@chw.org.
